Part One

A

- 1 R fwd
- 2-3 L fwd, bend L knee
- 4 R touch R (stretch L knee)
- 5-8 Reverse 1-4
- 9-16 Repeat 1-8

B

- 1-4 Yem R
- 5-8 Yem L
- 9 R fwd with $\frac{1}{2}$ turn CCW
- 10 L fwd
- 11 Repeat 9
- 12 L fwd and down (snap to L)
- 13 R to R and down (snap to R)
- 15-16 Face the center with two more snaps

C

- 1-2 Balance R to L
- 3-4 Brush and hold
- 5-8 Step together step with R
- 9-11 Reverse 5-8
- 12 Pivot L CW to make $\frac{1}{2}$ turn; start facing out

Part Two (variation only through the last part) Fast

- 1-4 Yem R
- 5-8 Yem L
- 9-16 Repeat 1-8

Part Three (Leaps)

- 1-4 RLRL (in a square)
- 5-16 Repeat Part Two
- 17-20 Step R, Kick L, Kick R, down and snap,

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
