9/8 counted 1-2, 1-2, 1-2, 1-2-3

BASIC STEP TO RIGHT

1

With wt on L, lift on L as R knee is raised with toe pointing down (ct 1-2), step R (ct 1-2), step L (ct 1-2), lift on L as R knee is raised (ct 1-2), step R (ct 3).

BASIC STEP TO LEFT

1

Reverse of above, wt on R, lift on R as L knee is raised with toe pointing down (ct 1-2), step L (ct 1-2), step R (ct 1-2) lift on R as L knee is raised (ct 1-2), step L (ct 3)

This is a flirtatious dance done free style with partners moving fwd and back, to R and L, occasionally turning--not too fast. Relax, smile and have fun...it's in the syllabus!
