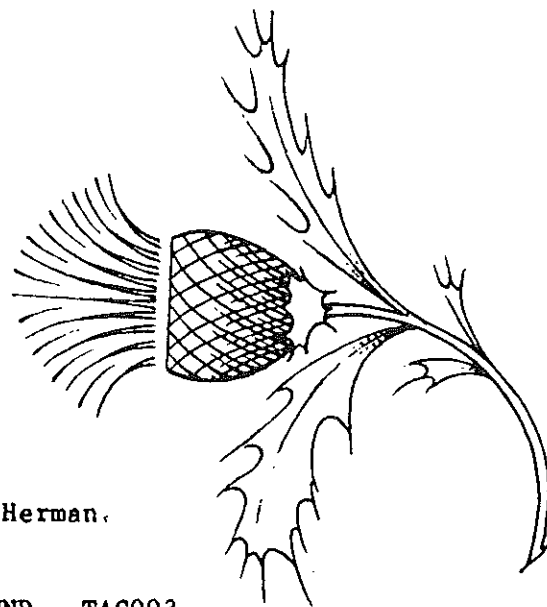


QUEEN OF MAINE FOLK DANCE CAMP
A Scottish Country Dance



A 32 bar strathspey for two couples.

- Bars:
- 1-8 First couple dance down the middle (3 bars) and up, then cast off (bars 7-8) to 2nd place ready for allemande. 2nd couple move up and to the center ready to lead the allemande.
- 9-16 Bars 1-6 as for a normal allemande. Bars 7-8, turn partner with th-right hand to finish with the 2nd couple facing down with right hands joined.
- 17-18 1st couple dance down under arch made by the 2nd couple, who dance up.
- 19-20 1st couple turn with the right hand $\frac{1}{2}$ way, then continue turning right individually to finish back to back in the center facing out. At the same time the 2nd couple cast off to 2nd place and finish facing in.
- 21-24 $\frac{1}{2}$ Reel of four across the dance. Finish with 1st couple in 2nd place, on their own side and 2nd couple in 1st place on the wrong sides.
- 25-26 1st and 2nd lady make a full turn with both hands.
- 27-28 1st and 2nd men make a full turn with both hands.
- 29-32 Turn partner with both hands, (1st couple make 2 turns, 2nd couple make $1\frac{1}{2}$ turns)
- REPEAT from new position.
