SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM:

The Folk Dance Federation, South has formed the Scholarship Program to: 1) develop potential folk dance teachers and leaders; 2) develop potential folk musicians; and 3) recognize individuals for service to and active participation in the folk dance community.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CONSIDERATION:

The following criteria have been established for eligibility and consideration for scholarship awards. The applicant: 1) must be a member of a Federation club or be recommended (sponsored) by an officer of the Federation; and 2) must not have received an FDFC,S scholarship within the past three years.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

A limited number of scholarships will be awarded, based on available funds. The scholarship covers up to **half the cost** of the camp's tuition (**excluding room and board**), and it covers only one camp per recipient during the 2017 calendar year.
